1. HANDICAPPED ACCESS BETWEEN TWO CIVIC CENTER BUILDINGS

Todd Ommen, Archi + Etc, LLC, was present to review the facilities and site assessment with the Commission regarding handicapped accessibility between the two Civic Center buildings. He and Jeremy Wagner discussed their assessment and reviewed the next steps if the Commission wishes to use the findings to create a request for proposals and seek bids.

Manager Sanley explained that the Civic Center is currently without wifi access. He has been in contact with the City of Seward and their contact, Bizco Technologies, and had more information about Matthew Schranz.
